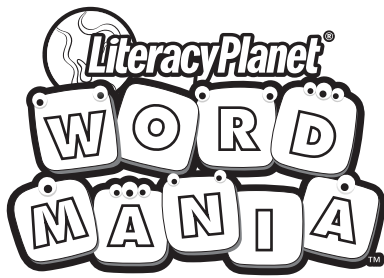

# Haiku

(Meaning 'to cut'.)

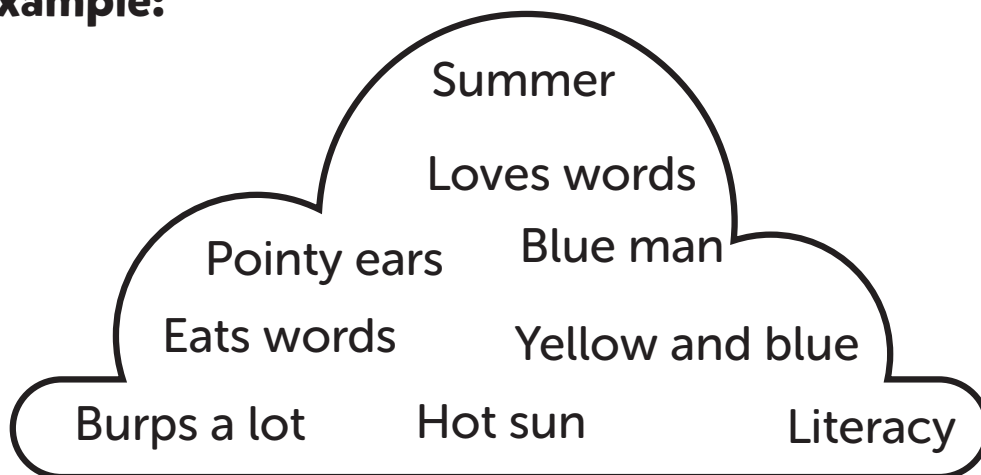
Create a haiku (peom) about Word Monster and your favourite season.

Use a punctuation mark or cutting word to separate or 'cut' between the ideas of Word Monster and your favourite season.

Traditional haiku consist of 17 syllables, in three phrases of 5, 7 and 5 syllables respectively. A 'kigo' or seasonal reference is usually also included.

Before you begin writing your poem, create a word cloud with words and ideas that come to mind when you think of your favourite season and what comes to mind when you see/think of Word Monster. This will help you create a more descriptive poem.

- (5) Chomping on green leaves
- (7) Burping on the words, he smiles
- (5) It is Word Mania time!
